
Now Available: Affordable Connectivity Program



The affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit that helps ensure that households can afford broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more. The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households.

Who is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

A household is eligible if one member of the household meets at least *one* of the following criteria:

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines or
- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, in the 2019-2020, 2020-2021, or 2021-2022 school year;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income program.
- **Please note, new eligibility requirements may allow customers to qualify who were not eligible for the Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBBP).**

Most customers who are already receiving the Emergency Broadband Benefit will automatically transfer to the \$30/month ACP credit after March 1, 2022. Households that need to re-qualify will be notified.
